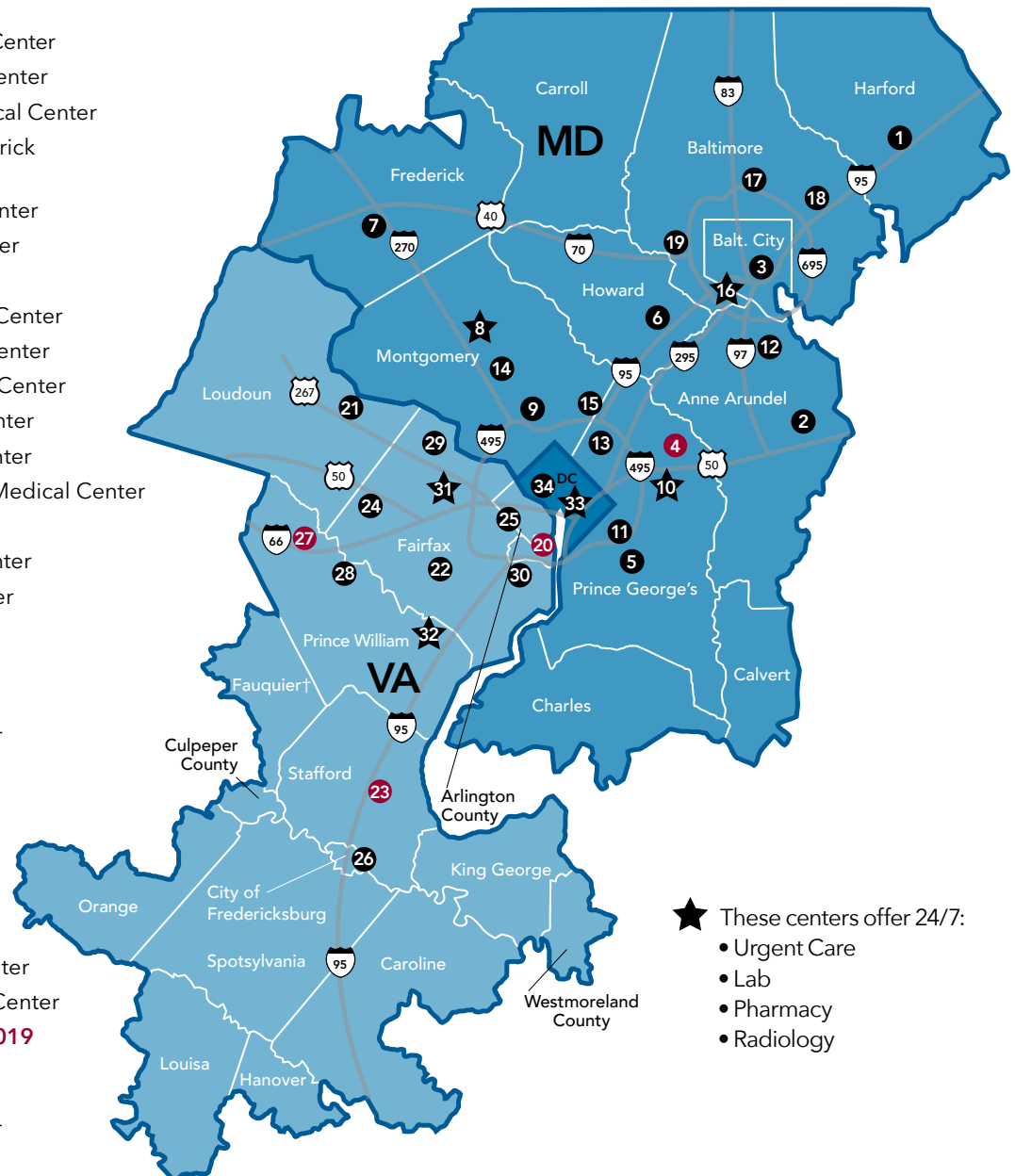

Most of our facilities offer a variety of care and services, so you can take care of several health care needs in one visit. You may be able to see your doctor or specialist, get a lab test or an X-ray, and pick up your medications—all without leaving the building.

### Urgent care<sup>3</sup>

These Kaiser Permanente Urgent Care locations are staffed with emergency medicine, family medicine, and internal medicine physicians supported by a full complement of nursing staff and technicians with access to advanced tools and technology.

### Emergency care<sup>4</sup>

If you ever need emergency care, you're covered worldwide—anytime, anywhere. Emergency care is for medical or mental health conditions that require immediate medical attention to prevent serious jeopardy to your health. Examples include:

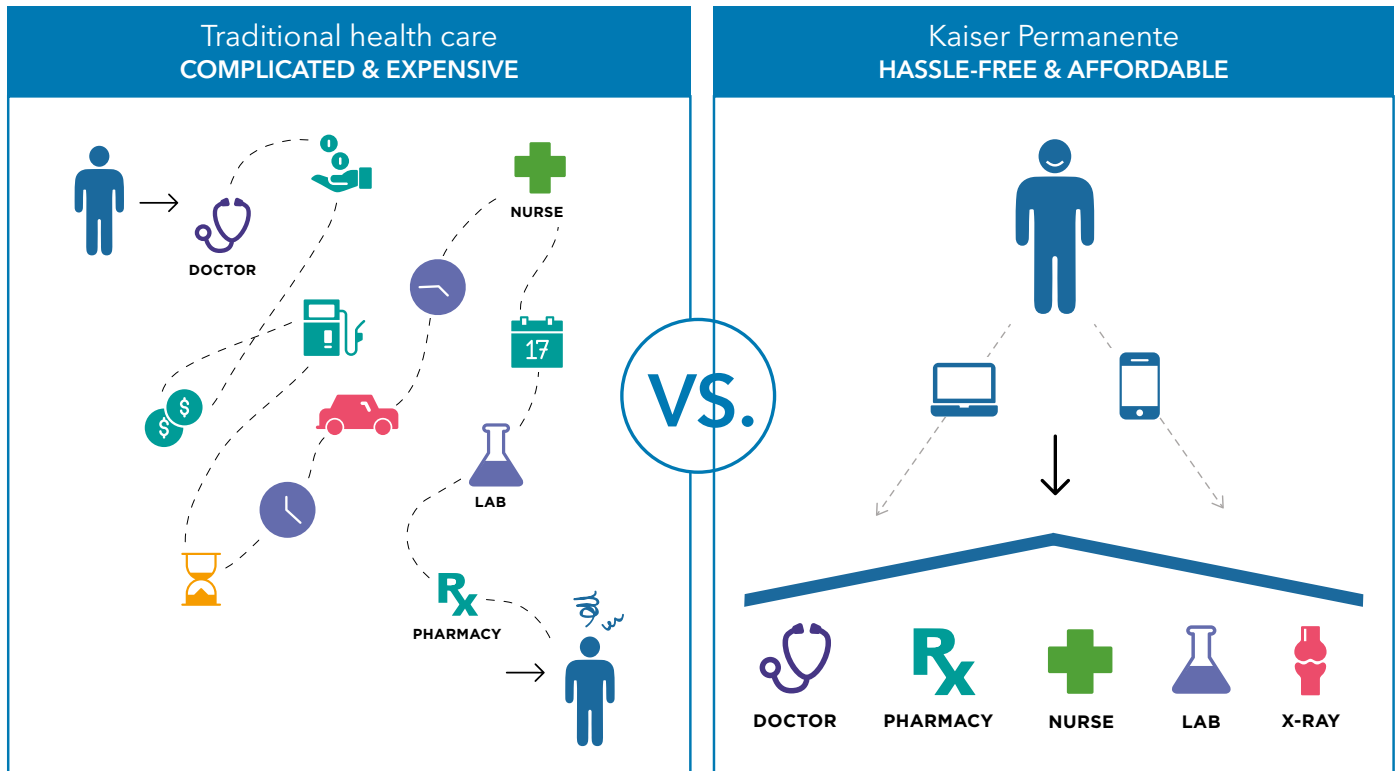

You must be present in Maryland, Virginia, or Washington, DC, for visits with your primary care physician or behavioral health provider. For urgent video visits with an emergency doctor, you may also be present in West Virginia, Florida, North Carolina, or Pennsylvania. For certain medical or mental health conditions. For video visits with a behavioral health provider, appointments can be scheduled for follow-up care.
- <sup>2</sup> Depending on your plan, preventive care services are covered at no cost or at a copay. For more information, see your *Evidence of Coverage* or *Summary Plan Description*.
