Updated Masking Guidelines (03-01-22)

In accordance with our policy to follow CDC guidelines for best practices to limit the spread of COVID-19 and keep our employees and guests safe, we are updating our mask policy. This policy may be further restricted by state or local laws, client policies or industry specific regulations.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

At this time, there is no change to the masking requirement for all Senior Living employees, specifically at St. Anthony's and The Cove. These employees must continue to mask indoors regardless of vaccination status.

The CDC recently moved from a masking advisory based on COVID-19 transmission rates to a **Community Level** based on new infections, hospitalizations, and available hospital beds.

Fully Vaccinated Employees (at least two weeks past the final dose)

When your County's **Community Level** is Low or Medium, you may choose not to mask indoors.

When your County's **Community Level** is High, you must mask indoors except when in your own private office or when eating or drinking at least six feet from another person.

Unvaccinated Employees

No change: unvaccinated employees must continue to mask indoors except when in your own private office or when eating or drinking at least six feet from another person.

Further, unvaccinated employees must continue to test weekly and upload their results to the Qualtrics Testing System.

The CDC's Prevention Steps based on **Community Levels** are as follows:

Low – Vaccinated May Go Maskless

- Stay up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines (get boosted if you haven't already)
- Get tested if you have COVID symptoms

Medium – Vaccinated and Healthy May Go Maskless

- If you are at high risk for severe illness, talk to your healthcare provider about whether you should wear a mask
- Stay up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines (get boosted if you haven't already)
- Get tested if you have COVID symptoms

High – All Must Mask Indoors

- Wear a mask indoors in public
- Stay up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines (get boosted if you haven't already)
- Get tested if you have COVID symptoms
- Additional precautions may be needed for people at high risk for severe illness

Any employee may choose to mask indoors regardless of your County's Community Level. Individuals with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask.

Guest Services strongly recommends that employees be Vaccinated and, if eligible, Boosted against the COVID-19 virus.
