

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

### **For Guest Services, Inc. Health and Welfare Benefit Plan**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Guest Services, Inc. Health and Welfare Benefit Plan, EIN 53-0164700 Plan No. 501, for the period January 01, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Insurance Information**

The plan has contracts with EyeMed Vision Care, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Mid-Atlantic, New York Life (Life Insurance Company of North America) and Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company to pay Accidental Death and Dismemberment, Business Travel Accident, Life, Long Term Disability, Medical, Prescription Drug and Vision claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2024 were \$1,174,612.

#### **Additional Plan Information**

Guest Services, Inc. has also committed itself to pay certain self-funded employee Dental, Health FSA, Medical and Prescription Drug claims incurred under the terms of the plan.
