Change Benefits: Workplace Giving Program

1. On your Workday home page click on Benefits and Pay.
2. Click on Change Benefits.
3. Choose Change Reason "Add/Update Workplace Giving Program" and enter today's date or a future date for Benefit Event Date. Click Submit.
4. Open the Change Benefit Elections task. Please note that it may have moved to your Workday Inbox awaiting your action.
5. Click on Let's Get Started and then on Enroll.
6. Select each of the charities of your choice and click on Confirm and then on Continue.
7. Under Coverage, select your charity. Under Per Paycheck Contribution, enter the amount you wish to donate. Click Save.
8. Repeat the steps under 7 for each charity.
9. Click on "Review and Sign".
10. Check off next to "I Accept" and click on Submit.
11. Click on "View 2026 Benefits Statement".
12. Click on Print and then on Download to save for your records.
